Keith Letchworth reported that Eastern AHEC has taken steps toward creating a Center for Excellence in School-Based Mental Health. Recent meetings have identified outcomes: developing a white paper on the need for school-based MH services, developing a concept paper and action plan for developing the Center for Excellence. Research on funding sources is underway. Family representatives are need for the project.</p> <p>The Substance Abuse Workgroup met on March 2, 2007. Paul Savery reported the group discussed barriers to services, RFA from the Division for available funding for SA services, and training needed to Child and Family Support Team staff, school health staff and community partners (ie. DSS and DJJ) in identifying SA issues.</p> <p>The Training and Technical Assistance Workgroup will meet on 3.9.07 at 11:30 in the Albemarle Building. The standing meeting for this group will be after the State Collaborative meeting on the 2nd Friday of the month. Rebecca Huffman and Kelly Crowley reported that the LME SOC Coordinators and a parent partner will receive the Child and Family Team Blended Curricula Mar 29/30 and April 9/10.
