Any child who is found to be homeless must be enrolled in public school immediately and provided with contact information for local homeless liaison. Families have the right to appeal the decision and LEAs must devise an appeal/dispute resolution process for this determination and submit to DPI by Nov. 15th. HB 1074 was also discussed to clarify procedure for admitting kids to school.</p>
